



# 2022 Fall High School Basketball Playbook

## General Information

- Location: Atlanta Jewish Academy (5200 Northside Dr, Atlanta, GA 30342)
- Sundays: August 21, 28, September 4, 11, 18, October 2, 9, 16
- Times: 5pm – 8pm
- Each team plays a minimum of 7 games
- Teams are required to supply their own jersey.
- Each team will need to fill out a roster prior to the first game.
- All necessary forms and payment must be completed prior to the first game.
- Score sheet is provided but teams usually also keep their own book.
- No outside coolers or food allowed .
- Concessions are available.
- Spectators are allowed into the games (Must Wear A Mask Even If Vaccinated)
- Entry Cost: \$2 adults / \$1 children (5 – 17)

## Game Rules

- Participants must be currently enrolled in school participating
- 8-minute quarters (4 quarters)
- Two (2) timeouts per team per game
- 2 officials per game officiating
- Foul rules are the same as high school. Seven (7) for the bonus, ten (10) for the double bonus.
- Players are permitted five (5) fouls before fouling out.
- Overtime is 3 minutes. 2nd overtime is 2 minutes
- One (1) technical foul for player or coach; One shot for two points and the ball taken out of bounds.
- Two (2) technical fouls in the same game for player or coach; disqualified for the 1st half of next scheduled game and One shot for two points and the ball taken out of bounds.

### **Free Throw Rule**

A player shoots one free throw for 2 or 3 points on all shooting fouls. Common fouls will be taken out of bounds unless the team has reached 7 team fouls or the 10 fouls for the double bonus. Then the player will shoot one free throw for 2 points. A player fouled on a made basket will shoot one free throw.

The last two minutes of the game in regulation or in overtime, all free throws will go back to normal 1, 2 or 3 shots depending on the situation.

### **COVID GUIDELINES**

#### **COVID Exposure**

If a participant presents with symptoms or has had a recent direct exposure, the participant will be removed from activity and will not be allowed to return until: 1) Proof of a negative COVID 19 test; and 2) 14-day quarantine and symptom free. If at any time a student participant/coach/staff tests positive for COVID 19, all other members of that workout group will be notified and will not be allowed to return until: 1) Proof of a negative COVID 19 test is determined.

When a student athletic participant or staff member screens positive, they will be sent home to Self-Isolate for 14 days and directed to appropriate resources. They will be instructed to follow up with a primary care physician or other appropriate physician or practice. The athlete or staff member will be allowed to return to campus after a note from the Doctor confirming COVID19 test was negative or providing a diagnosis that illness was related to a different situation. All athletes who are assigned to the same group as any athlete who tests positive for Covid-19 will be required to follow the same procedures.
